When Having Windows Installed

1. Depending on the size of the project, windows are removed and replaced one at a time. If a room can be sealed off from the rest of the house, we may remove all the windows in the room prior to installing the new ones.
2. We recommend that the homeowner remove window treatments before the installation team arrives. (Including shades and blinds). This allows for easy access to the window openings. Ornaments and other decorations should also be removed from the glass.
3. We will require an area of about four feet around each window opening to work safely. You will want to move some furnishings and collectibles beyond that area.
4. Your installation may require us to work from the exterior as well as the interior. Although our team takes care to avoid damaging outdoor plantings, you should consider additional precautions to protect any prized garden flowers or bushes.
5. After the windows arrive in warehouse and are inspected, the installers will contact you to schedule an installation date and time that works best for you.
6. Windows can be installed at temperatures above 20 degrees F. However, inclement weather (storms, etc.) may cause your date to be rescheduled. Unless you get a call from the installers, assume they will be there as scheduled.
7. Smaller projects may be combined on the same day. An unexpected delay on a previous installation may cause our team to be late for your appointment. If that happens, they will make an effort to call to advise you.
8. Before the installers begin, decide which entrance you want them to use. They will have plastic to protect your flooring, but you'll want to make certain anything that can be damaged has been moved and you have provided the guys with a clear path.
9. For safety's sake, please take care to keep both children and pets from the installation site during the entire process.
10. Windoor and our team of certified installers are fully insured and bonded.
11. The old windows are loaded and disposed of by the installers. If you want to keep them, please discuss this with them - however, we cannot guarantee that they can be removed without damage.
12. There's a fair amount of dust created when old windows are removed. Although we do our best to not make a mess, it's best to cover your furnishings in the area of the installations to keep them clean. Our team will clean up and take with them any debris created during the removal and installation.
13. In many cases, the window is wrapped with a maintenance free coil stock that matches your new window to finish the exterior. The standard color used matches the window. If you have another preference, other charges may apply.
